Teaching Notes

Choose the version of the reader that is just right for your students.
Both have bolded vocabulary & life cycle words which are featured on the included vocab word wall cards.

The first version includes basic text. The second version includes additional vocabulary and is more complex. Both readers are offered in blackline versions for easy printing. Students can color them if you'd like.

To print, print the pages you'd like to include. Staple twice along the left side (some copiers can do this for you) and cut in half for two readers.

The vocabulary word wall cards that are included are great for:

1. preteaching the vocabulary
2. Supporting writing and sequencing activities
3. Match the word to the picture (you can even do this before reading, and have students self monitor/ self correct as they read to see if they matched the words correctly).

Extension response:

There are two versions of sequencing as well as some scrambled sentences to use as independent practice, morning work, or during reading group as a response.
