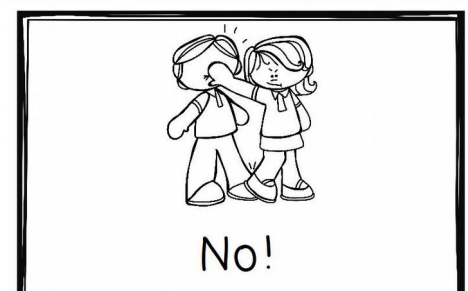
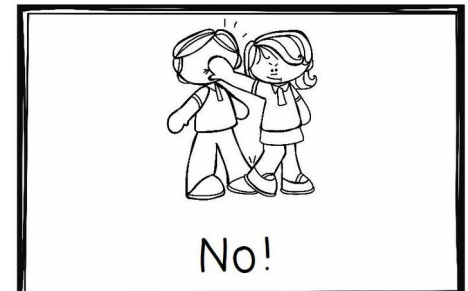
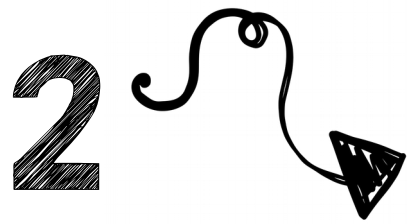
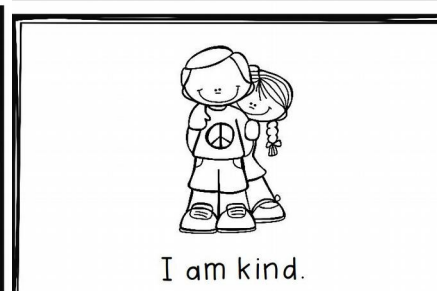
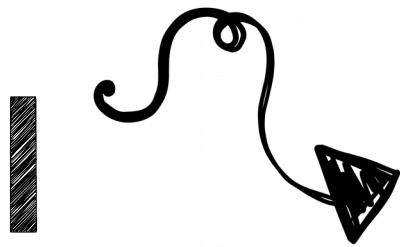
Teaching Notes

This set includes three different versions of emergent readers for students to review school rules and classroom expectations.

These books go along great with class discussions and prompting of students to model different "Yes!" scenarios.

There are also classroom rules cards great for sorting as a class on a pocket chart. There are smaller cards for students to complete a sort on their own as well (one version with 6 cards and a sheet to glue onto and one version with 12 cards for students to glue onto a large sheet of construction paper).
