

So here I go, fast and perky! I'm a very clever turkey!








Thanksgiving Dinner Shape Poem Project

Make a list of words all about Thanksgiving dinner and then make a shape poem!




Marrative Writing Prompts & Book Writing

TEACHING NOTES Thanksgiving Writing Resources

Descriptive Writing Shape Poem

Informational Writing- Use any bookor resource in your classrom about Squanto, Pilgrims, Native Americans, or Turkeys. Use the graphic organizers and writing pages to do some informational writing. There are two line sizes for writing about each topic.

Letter Writing (persuasive): Give the turkey a disguise. Then write to convince someone that you're not a turkey at all! I have had students color on the turkeys, but the most fun they had was when I copied the turkey template on cardstock and then they used construction paper scraps to make the parts to the disguise.

Opinion Writing: Two prompts have been included. Each has differentiated graphic organizers with blanks or with sentence stems to guide writers.

Narrative Writing: I have included two narrative prompts. You can make the book template that works for your students. There are guiding words in the turkey on the corner of each page to help students focus their writing. I have included story parts, as well as transition words, and even a blank page so you can print the booklet version just right for your students.

Descriptive Writing- This shape poem activity is a super fun one for Thanksgiving time. There are individual instructions for this activity.
